Course Content

Module 1—Steering and Suspension Overview

The student will gain an understanding of what to look for when identifying types of steering systems, steering systems parts and parts of front and rear suspension systems.

Module 2—Damage Analysis

He or she will begin to examine several damage analysis considerations. They will gain an understanding of how to properly analyze steering and suspension issues, determine which types of damage can cause specific problems and identify testing procedures for steering and suspension damage analysis. The student will also learn about performing steering and suspension quick checks, analyzing parts for damage, suspension alignment angles and diagnosing damage by interpreting alignment angles.

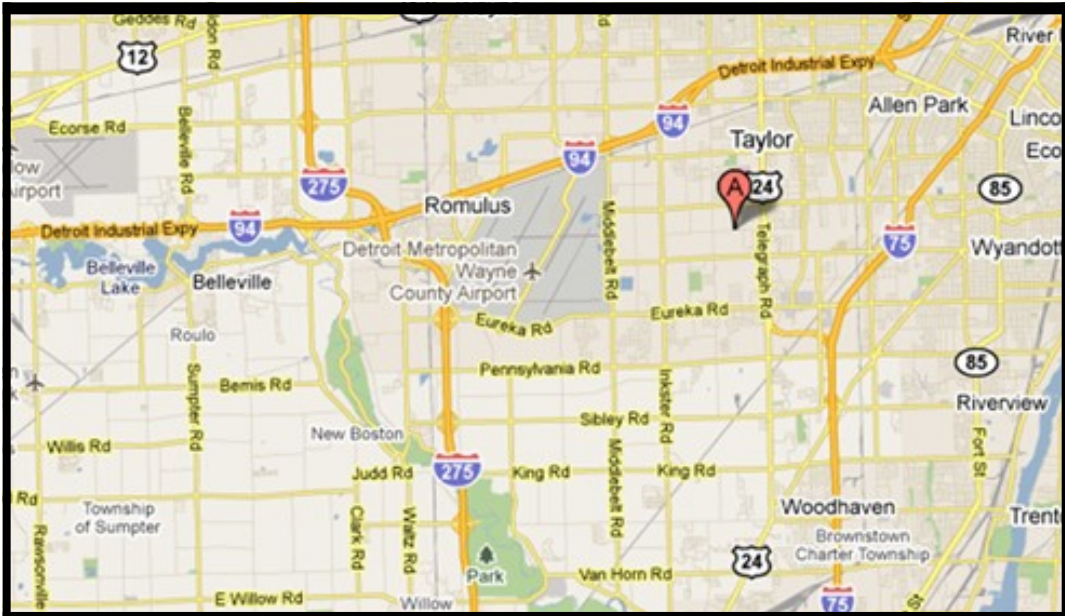
